

## Volunteer Years of Service Pin Overview

The Years of Service pin recognizes an adult member registered with Girl Scouts of the U.S.A. for her/his years of active volunteer service at five-year intervals (5, 10, 15, etc.).

**Criteria:** The candidate is a registered Girl Scout adult member.

**Request process:**

1. 15 or more years of service:

- ❖ Complete Years of Service Pin form and submit to:

2. 10 years or less of service:

- ❖ Do not submit form to council office.
- ❖ Complete years of service pin form.
- ❖ Purchase years of service pin from the council shop to be presented at an appropriate service unit and/or area event meeting.

**Form of recognition:** The years of service pin indicates in five (5) year intervals the total number of years of active service. It is a gold tone frame with the words “Girl Scout Volunteer” surrounding a blue enamel area inscribed with the number of years. It is worn on the right side of the uniform below the personalized identification pin.

**Form to be used:** Volunteer Years of Service Pin Request RE-0134-.

**Deadline:** March 5 by 4:30 p.m.

**Award presentation:** At the Annual Meeting and Recognitions Event for 15 years or more or at an appropriate service unit and/or area event meeting and for 10 years or less at an appropriate service unit and/or area event meeting.
